Participants will be required to:

- Attend 6 day courses,
- Complete 3 assessments
- 1 observed session
- 10 sessions in a youth work setting

Who should attend?

- People with 1 years experience in a youth work setting
- Currently working or volunteering in youth work in Highland
- Interested in gaining SQA accredited qualification
- Able to commit to all 6 dates

This is a course delivered by Youth Highland using course materials developed by Youth Scotland and Area Associations

This course will develop your understanding of theory and practice in youth work and help you in your role as a youth worker.

The course will enable participants to develop knowledge and skills in various areas including:

- Context, core values and principles of youth work.
- Understanding issues facing young people and youth workers
- Communication and group work skills
- Different approaches in youth work
- Youth Work settings
- Plan, Deliver, Review

The course provides a sound base for progression to further study and vocationally related qualifications.
